

# BELLINGEN CORDLESS LAMP

Celebrating the beauty of timber.





#### THE BEGINNING

Artist/Photographer Anne Gothe and Industrial Designer Peter Ellis founded NEOZ Lighting in 1983, creating original luminaires of the highest quality construction and design. Innovation and breakthrough continued into the 1990's when NEOZ Lighting developed award winning Lightrail and Lightwire track systems.

#### **BIRTH OF CORDLESS**

In 1995 we were working on the lighting design for Penfold Wine's Magill Estate restaurant in the Adelaide hills with Sydney architects Allen Jack+Cottier. A major challenge with restaurant lighting is their need to move tables around and still illuminate them appropriately; we were tasked with designing an electric lamp with no cord to solve this problem. The NEOZ Lighting cordless lamp was born.





#### PROUDLY AUSTRALIAN

NEOZ is proudly Australian and supports local craftsmen and artisans in the creation of its many lamps.

The Bellingen lamp is no exception.

Timber has timeless style and here at NEOZ, we wanted to create a new lamp design that celebrates the beauty of Australian timber, in a sensual form. We did this by creating an attractive yet modest bottle shape that accentuates the delicate layering of wood grain, which envelopes the lamp control unit.

#### CAMPHOR LAUREL

The Bellingen lamp is primarily constructed from sustainably sourced timber with a solid brass lampshade holder. The Camphor Laurel tree's timber is prepared and crafted by local craftsman Jack Buchanan, a 2nd generation wood worker.

The Bellingen lamp is crafted from the wood of the Camphor Laurel tree in Dorrigo, a small town located on the Northern Tablelands, in northern New South Wales, Australia.





# SUSTAINABLE LUXURY

We locally source sustainable Camphor Laurel timber following strict sustainable practices. Harvested in Northern New South Wales in Dorrigo, the whole process from logging, drying, turning, and finishing are documented.

### NATURALLY ANTI-BACTERIAL

Camphor Laurel is a dense, evergreen tree producing a hard-wood timber that is known for its rich honeycoloured woodgrain, which is fragranced with and reminiscent of the crisp and clean camphor smell of its leaves when crushed. Its timber is naturally anti-bacterial because of the natural oils embedded within the timber, hence reducing microbial growth.

### EASY CHARGING OPTIONS

Choose from a range of recharging solutions – from a single base station to a 48-lamp trolley. Just place your lamp on the docking point, and the visual charging status will tell you when it's fully charged.



### WATER RESISTANT

The body of the Bellingen lamp is finished with Osmo satin oil, a natural hard wax oil protection making it also water-repellent and dirt-resistant, with the finish being resistant against most drinks that may come into contact with it (we're talking wine, beer, cola, coffee, tea, fruit juices, milk and water).

# IMPERFECTLY PERFECT AS NATURE INTENDED

Camphor Laurel timber is a natural dynamic material and every piece is unique in colour and grain pattern. The heartwood varies widely in colour from pale to mid brown and is often streaked with darker brown or red. This makes the Bellingen lamp the perfect hand crafted creation to celebrate how imperfectly perfect timber is, just as nature intended.

## SEDUCTIVE SHAPE

This seductive bottle shaped lamp is made of "Dominate Heartwood" coloured Camphor Laurel and is a pleasing addition and the perfect natural touch to any environment.

#### PICK YOUR SHADE

This handcrafted cordless lamp can be paired with a hand-made cotton lampshade or a hand-blown glass lampshade, providing a direct downlight and soft diffused sidelight.
